Dr. Cindy Schulmeyer, HCPSS Coordinator of Psychological Services

- School based programs and staff
- Multi-tiered systems for support for mental health

- Suicide prevention in schools
- Community Collaboration
 - Question: what if any Mental Health Care can hcpss provide without parental consent?
 - A: HCPSS counselors will notify the parents if the student meets with them
 - Q: What is the restorative justice program?
 - A: a program to help students work together and support each other. We make community circles in classrooms, this sets the stage if a challenging situation needs to be discussed. If students are arguing, the teacher might pull together a community circle, discuss what they could do differently. Its about having the relationship built first, so that we can repair damaged relationships
 - Q: So the teacher facilitates?
 - A: The teacher starts it, but can bring in the support staff. Its not uncommon to bring in a support staff, but we want teachers to do as much as possible on their own
 - Q: where can parents find SEL for a specific grade?
 - A: Collaborative Classroom link, also to go into link for school counselors which provides the link for counselor goals
 - Q: What is the policy if someone is sexually assaulted?
 - A: It is a Title 9 violation, so they would work with the school admin, or they can use the bullying form to report and the school admin will follow up with you.
 - Q: specifically about the LGBTQIA community: specifically, what experience do counselors have within individual schools sto address this community? Do students feel comfortable approaching teachers and counselors?

- A: We have the LGBTQIA advisory council, which engages in creating training for staff, staff receives specific training about supports and services they can provide in schools. Very active community. Every school identified a Rainbow representative, through the CARY org, so that schools can provide help to families.
